Finances

The EBC Georgia provided room and board for the teachers. Travel costs of all the teachers were provided by either the churches or the Baptist Unions from which the teachers came.

There were only very few donations for running the program and to support the students so that only a minimum could be accomplished. The budget did not allow buying any material and special equipment which would have been helpful.

Future Perspectives

All students of the first course have demanded to continue with the theological education. Their proposal is to use intensive courses of two weeks in the summer and concentrate on one subject.

During the week after the graduation about 50 new students have applied for the next course although nothing has been said about a next "School of Elijah" program.
